The completed Student Housing Application and the non-refundable \$50 application fee are due on May 11, 2017. This fee should be paid via TouchNet. The completed application should be mailed to Malkie Katz at 227 W 60th Street, New York, NY 10023. Applications will be processed in the order that they are received. At the discretion of the school, additional information may be required.

To hold a space in the dorm, a \$300 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is due by 5:00 PM EST on May 25th, 2017. A bed will not be held for anyone that does not pay the \$300 deposit by May 25th. Deposits should be paid via TouchNet. *Anyone not accepted to student housing will be notified by the end of June. In the event that a student is not accepted the \$300 deposit will be refunded.*

** A student who applies for student housing pays a \$50 non-refundable application fee. If she doesn't come, we allow her to roll over the \$50 for the next semester only. To specify, if the student applies for the Fall semester, we permit her to roll over to the Spring semester only. If she applies for the Spring semester, we permit her to roll over to the following Fall semester only. If the student wishes to defer she needs to submit a letter via e-mail to the Dean by November 1st or March 1st indicating that she would like to come the following semester. The student understands that deferring for the next immediate semester, does not guarantee a place in student housing (even if she was offered a place for the previous semester).*

In addition, a student must pay a \$300 non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit to hold the bed. This fee does not roll over to the following semester. If a student does not attend, even if she defers for only one semester, she forfeits her \$300 deposit. That means that if the student pays the \$300 student housing deposit for the Fall and then defers, she will need to pay another \$300 as a student housing deposit for the Spring semester. If a student pays a student housing deposit for the Spring and defers, that \$300 is non-refundable and non-transferrable and she will not be able to use that money for the following semester. Students need to understand that there are no exceptions to this policy.

In the event that a student is not accepted the \$300 will be refunded. Anyone not accepted to student housing will be notified by the end of June.

In summary: the \$50 application fee can be rolled over for a single semester; the \$300 residence facility deposit cannot be rolled over.
